River Run art contest requirements and guidelines

• The art contest is open to current 8th grade students in Holy Family Catholic Schools and the Dubuque Community School District.

GUIDELINES

- Artwork must focus on the theme of the Mississippi River.
- Artwork must be no larger than 24 inches by 24 inches and no smaller than 8 inches by 8 inches.
- Artwork must be two-dimensional in nature and may be paintings, drawings, collage, prints or photography.
- Artwork should be unmatted and unframed and must be suitable for hanging and display using two-sided tape or another appropriate adhesive. No name identification nor images may appear on the artwork.
- Only one work of art per student may be submitted.
- Each work must have paper-clipped to it the completed Dubuque Chorale Art Contest entry form.
- Artwork will be evaluated by a panel of judges assembled by Mark Wahlert, Executive Director of the Dubuque Museum of Art.
- Winning entries will be selected by a panel of judges based on creativity, technique, and artistic value.

Deadline: All entries due by March 14th, 2014.

Prizes: 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place winners will receive cash prizes of \$100.00, \$75.00, and \$50.00 respectively. A certificate of honorable mention will also be awarded to the 4th place winner. The top four winning submissions will also be displayed at the Dubuque Chorale's performances of Let The River Run on April 25th and May 2nd.
