The first concert is Sunday Oct 24 at 3 pm at the First Congregational Church in downtown Dubuque. No tickets are needed but there will be a free will offering. We will again sing with the Dubuque Symphony Orchestra for Holiday Pops Dec 4-5 at Five Flags.

2021 was our 50th Anniversary and we will celebrate this May 14, 2022, 7:30 pm and May 15, 2:00 pm at the Grand Opera House. Past directors will participate and old classics are programmed along with the debut of a commissioned piece "Amendment: Righting Our Wrongs." An orchestra will accompany the Chorale and Children's Choir.

Consider joining us to sing, or encourage your friends and relatives. The rehearsals are Thursday nights 7-9 pm at Grand View United Methodist Church. No auditions are required. Options are available for singing just part of the year. Check the website for details. Even just singing the Christmas concert is a good introduction (no dues for this).

The Children's Choir continues to foster musical appreciation and talent at the 3-6 grade level. They will sing Nov 13 at NISOM's Public Library series, the Ecumenical Thanksgiving service Nov 24, Family Holiday Pops Dec 4, and at the 50th Anniversary concert May 14-15, 2022.
